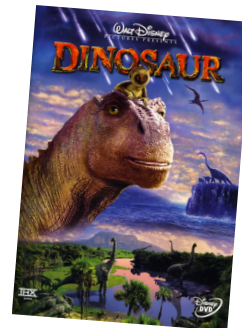
JURASSIC MARK LIVE ACTION

This painting class will be taught by Micah from Silas Ridge Studio! A grown up and up to two kids will all paint separate scenes on canvases that will later go together!

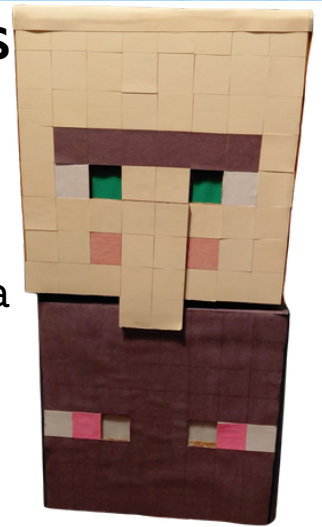
